

Vail/Avon Lacrosse Shootout Field Directions

Ford Field:

This field is the main field in Vail. It is located approximately one (1) mile east from downtown Vail along the frontage road. The main exit to downtown Vail is exit #176. Go under the interstate and from the roundabout head east on the frontage road. The field is past the parking structure and a set of condos on your right. Parking is tight and is limited to the east end of the tennis courts (paid parking most days) or the public parking garage (free in the summer). It is advisable to park in the parking structure and make the short walk.

Athletic Field:

This field is in Vail and is located approximately one (1) mile east from downtown Vail on Vail Valley Drive. Take the main exit to downtown Vail, exit #176. Go under the interstate and from the roundabout head east on the frontage road. At the stop sign after the parking garage which is Vail Valley Drive, take a right. Wind down across Gore Creek, up and past Golden Peak Ski School, then you'll see the field on your right hand side. It has a small parking lot, which is paid parking. If that is full, park by Ford Field in the paid lot or in the parking structure which is free and take the walking path between the fields. On July 4 it might be best to park in the parking garage and walk, since parts of Vail Valley Drive are on the parade route.

Edwards:

Go west of Vail on I-70. Off of I-70 take the Edwards exit #163. Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Proceed under the interstate and past the Wendy's and gas station. Turn left on Miller Ranch Road and follow it to the fields which are about ½ mile.

Avon Field 1 and Avon Field 2:

Take I-70 west. Go 8 miles past West Vail. Take the Avon/Beaver Creek exit. Take a left on to Avon Road (under the interstate).

For Avon 1 - Turn right on Benchmark. Park in the lots next to the Avon Municipal building. It is approximately a 1/4 mile walk along the lake from Field 1 to Field 2.

For Avon 2 - Turn right on Beaver Creek West Blvd. Follow it for approx- ½ mile to the school. Park in the school lot on your left before the railroad tracks. Be sure to follow all posted speed limit signs.

Donovan:

This is a secondary field in Vail used for the Super Masters. Take the main exit to Vail, exit #176. Go under the interstate and from the roundabout head west on the frontage road toward Lionshead and Cascade Village. The field is on your left. If you hit West Vail, you've gone too far.

Vail Mountain School:

This field is in East Vail. Head east on the frontage road toward Ford Field. Continue east as you pass Ford Field until you go under I-70. Continue east approximately a quarter mile. The Vail Mountain School is on your left hand side. Parking is available in the adjacent parking lot.

Eagle Vail Pavilion:

Go west of Vail on I-70. Off of I-70 take Exit #169. Turn right on Highway 6 and turn left on Eagle Rd. Follow this road for about 1 mile, the pavilion is on your right past Eagle Dr. Park in the lot next to the field or on Eagle Rd.

Berry Creek Middle School:

Go west of Vail on I-70. Off of I-70 take the Edwards exit (#163). Turn right at the bottom of the ramp. You'll then be taking your first right onto Berry Creek Road. Go to the 2nd stop sign and turn right on to Windsor Road. Follow Windsor under the highway and directly to the school.

Chip Ramsey Park:

Go west of Vail on I-70. Off of I-70 take the Edwards exit (#163). Turn right at the bottom of the ramp. You'll then be taking your first right onto Berry Creek Road. Go to the 2nd stop sign. The park is at the intersection. Park in the lot on the other end of the field.
